Continued from page 1... specific items that they will need to bring. Safety gear and equipment are a part of the club's rules, as well as the site's rules.

At noon, we'll drive to the KOA across from the Herkimer Diamond Mines & set up camp. Saturday evening is for family activities wcs, campfires, smores & rock exchanges. Sunday morning is a pancake breakfast followed by a day of digging. If our numbers are adequate, we can get discounts as follows:

If we have at least 12 people for digging on Sunday, the Herkimer Diamond Mines will charge us a group rate of \$6.50 per person. [Normal cost is \$8.00 per person.]

They will prepare a Pancake breakfast for a group of 15 or more on Sun. morning if we desire. Cost is \$3.75 you get 3 pancakes, sausage or bacon, & drink. Let Pat or Bill Chapman know by Sept. 1st if you want breakfast so they can schedule the appropriate staff. If our numbers are smaller, Pat's cooking. She's got a kitchen.

Camp sites, Kabin & Kottage costs vary from \$25 to \$99.00. They recommend families contact them SOON to secure their sites.
